

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BRAZOS COUNTRY, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORAL PROCLAMATION ON 26<sup>TH</sup> MARCH, 2020, IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus)**

**WHEREAS**, on the 26<sup>th</sup> of March, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Brazos Country, Texas, issued a mayoral proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City of Brazos Country, in response to a Public Health Emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist; and


**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code, a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governmental body of the political subdivision; now, therefore,


**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRAZOS COUNTRY, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.**

The declaration of disaster, which was signed and executed by Albert A. Sykes, Mayor, on March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2020, shall be renewed and continued until terminated by the governing body of the City of Brazos Country, Texas.
